

Safety Officers Report

Dave,

That's an unusual salutation from RDRC's deputy, appointed, secondary safety officer, but we were at the mall with all its temptations and not the field.

I've not heard of any notable safety violations this month. I will suggest that when retrieving a disabled or crashed plane, do so quickly if its remnants are on the runway or adjacent grass areas.

Do the post mortem back in the pits. Be sure to call out to the flight line that you are on the field retrieving a plane or are looking for pieces after the primary remains are in the pits.

Don't interfere with the takeoffs and landings of others.

Be respectful of other's needs and the role safety plays in our hobby.

And always remember, "We don't need no stinkin gravity!"


