April 26—Excerpted from the funeral service for Tom: “Born in Raymond, Mississippi, Tom attended public schools in Jackson, MS, Mississippi College, New Orleans Baptist Theological Seminary and Florida State University. He served the Wake Forest School of Medicine for 30 years prior to his appointment as associate professor emeritus in 2001. Dr. Clark will be remembered as a gifted clinician with a wonderful sense of humor who could treat patients without their saying a word. During his career as a marriage and family therapist in the Department of Psychiatry and Behavioral Medicine, Dr. Clark... received numerous awards and honors.... He is survived by his wife, Kathryn Summers Clark, Ph.D.; by his two sons T. Michael Clark and Steven D. Clark and by his grandchildren.... Tom not only taught us how to live joyously, but he also taught us how to handle death with grace and dignity..”
