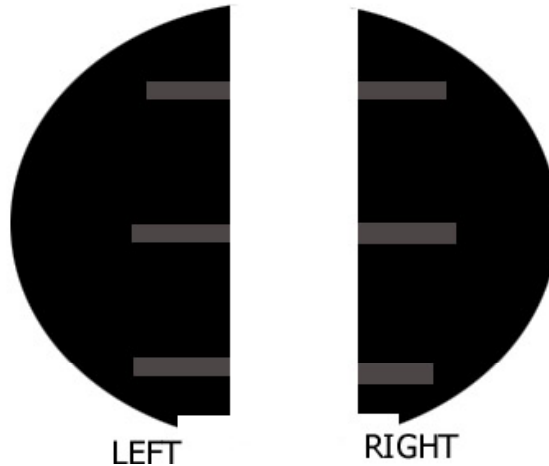


Instructions for Installing Scootworks Deluxe Engine Guard Chaps

1. Open your package and lay the Deluxe Engine Guard Chaps on the floor or ground as shown in the illustration below. Your chaps may have two or three straps, depending on the model. The rear of the chaps (the side that will be facing rearward when installed) will have Velcro pads for quick attachment of the straps, while the front side of the chaps have the straps sewn permanently attached.



2. The illustration above demonstrates the way the chaps will be installed when you are sitting on your motorcycle seat looking at the chaps. When installed correctly, the straps will attach to the Velcro pads that face towards the rear of your bike.

3. Install the RH chap on the RH side of your engine guard, by opening the wide Velcro lined side of the chap and sliding the opening over your engine guard. Slide the chap all the way to the frame of your motorcycle. Close the Velcro on the opening to help hold the chap in place.

4. Insert the straps around your frame downtubes to secure the chap to your motorcycle. Pull the straps tight and close the Velcro, to remove any free play in the chap. On Honda 750 and 1100 models, pass the lowest strap for the RH chap through the horn bracket and on to the back side of the chap (**NOT** around the downtube), to provide additional clearance for the chap from the front exhaust pipe.

5. Once you have the chaps installed the way you want them, you may wish to trim any excess strap for a neat appearance, though leaving the straps long improve ease of installation. Chaps are a functional product for adverse weather, and not designed to be a fashion statement. For this reason, most customers leave the straps long.

6. Repeat the procedure on the LH side of your engine guard. Honda 750 and 1100 models will pass all 3 straps around the frame downtube and secure (no horn bracket on the LH side to be concerned with).

7. That's it, you're almost finished. Wash with soap and water, and no weather proofing/treatment is required. more step.
